#### **B.Sc Honours (Botany) Admission Process**

Admissions to B.Sc Honours (Botany) are done on the basis of merit. The government of Andhra Pradesh notifies the admission process and asks registration for convener quota of 17 seats. The remaining 08 seats will be in management quota. For management quota consult the college office or use chat bot for enquiry.
