Programme: B.Com Honours (General)

B.Com Honours (General) is a Bachelor's course of four years which is the most pursued graduation course in the field of commerce, covering subjects such as Accounting, Taxation, Economics, Financial Management, etc. Students who aspire to have a career in the finance and accounting sector usually pursue this course, with an average starting salary of around INR 3-8 LPA with career prospects such as Cost Accountant, Business Analyst, Economist, Stock Broker, Finance Advisor, Tax Consultant, and others.

B.Com Honours (General): What is it about?

- The program has been designed to offer eligible candidates specialization in a wide range of skills required in the finance and accounting sector, while at the same time building competence in a particular area of business & commerce.
- Successful graduates of the course interested in pursuing further studies in the discipline may go for pursuing MBA or M.Com.

Accountant	The main job of an Accountant is to perform financial calculations for the best benefits of tex and business.	INR 2.48 LPA
