It notes that "given the 21st century requirements, quality higher education must aim to develop good, thoughtful, wellrounded, and creative individuals" and enable an individual to study one or more specialized areas of interest at a deep level, and also develop capabilities across a range of disciplines including sciences, social sciences, arts, humanities, languages, as well as professional, technical, and vocational subjects. The NEP highlights certain fundamental principles that would guide both the education system at large, as well as the individual educational institutions. The principles that have a direct bearing on the curricula for different levels of higher education include: Recognizing, identifying, and fostering the unique capabilities of each student to promote her/his holistic development; Flexibility, so that learners have the ability to choose their learning trajectories and programmes, and thereby choose their own paths in life according to their talents and interests; Emphasis on conceptual understanding rather than rote learning and learning-for- exams; creativity and critical thinking to encourage logical decision-making and innovation; ethics and human & constitutional values, and life skills such as communication, cooperation, teamwork, and resilience; Full equity and inclusion as the cornerstone of all educational decisions to ensure that all students are able to thrive in the education system and ensuring that the institutional environment is responsive to differences to ensure that high-quality education is available for all.

I fondly wish we all fully embrace the NEP with Body, Mind and Soul in unison.



and showed their talent in stock


